The Minnesota State Bar Association Access to Justice Committee brought to my attention a small number of attorneys whose commitment to pro bono has been exceptional. You are one of those few.

I am writing to thank you for your extraordinary service representing Minnesotans in need of legal help. Last year you devoted 640 hours of pro bono service over a wide range of legal issues. You took on a cold-call asylum case to help an individual afraid to return to his home country because of his sexual orientation. In addition, you helped the Innocence Project review a case to determine if the conviction was wrongful. You also represented an organization fighting for the rights of immigrants and victims of human trafficking, agreeing to expedite the organization's FOIA requests and to seek recourse in court if needed.

Equal justice under the law is the most fundamental promise of our justice system. A judicial system that is accessible only to those who can afford it does not keep that promise.
